Motorized and Non-Motorized

Wednesday April 12th 2017 will be the last day of grooming for Snowmobile and Nordic trails. Grooming will be done Wednesday evening. Trails from Obsidian Dome back to Shady Rest will be groomed.

(ALL LAWS AND CLOSED AREA ARE STILL INEFFECT EVEN WHEN GROOMING IS NOT GOING ON. SNOWMOBILES PLEASE STAY OUT OF THE WILDERNESS AND OBSIDIAN DOME NORDIC AREA)

- Orange trails are groomed motorized trails, open to all users. Non-motorized users of these trails should use caution and listen for motorized traffic. *Motorized users should always slow to 15 mph in congested areas.* When riding on a trail that passes through a corridor, please observe the closures on either side of the trail.
- Dark Blue trails are groomed and open to all non-motorized users, but are not open to any motorized traffic.
- Shaded blue areas are closed to all winter motorized traffic. Help keep motorized riding areas open by making sure you are not riding in wilderness or an administrative closed area.
- All groomed trails are closed to wheeled traffic. Thank you for your cooperation.
- Dog walkers are welcome on these trails if your dog is on a leash, you must bag waste and dispose properly at Shady Rest Trailhead or other waste receptacle. Failure to comply with dog laws will result in a fine.
